1 PROPHESIED – The Journey of the Gospel Foretold Isaiah 53:5 (KJV)

- Covenant in Promise Genesis 3:15, God's covenant with Abraham, Moses, and David
- Captured in Patterns Sacrificial system pointing to Christ (Passover lamb, burnt offerings)
- Confirmed by Prophets Isaiah 7:14, Isaiah 9:6, Isaiah 53

2 PERSONIFIED – The Journey of the Gospel Fulfilled John 1:14 (KJV)

- Christ Came Fulfilled prophecy, born of a virgin in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2)
- Christ Conquered Miracles, authority over sickness, demons, nature
- Christ Carried the Cross Death, resurrection, and victory over sin

③ PERSECUTED − The Journey of the Gospel Under Fire Matthew 27:22-23 (KJV)

- Challenged by Leaders Rejected by religious rulers and Roman officials
- Corrupted by Lies/Heresy False teachings (Gnosticism, Arianism) attacked the truth
- Confirmed at Nicaea Church leaders stood for Jesus' divinity (325 AD)

COUNCIL OF NICAEA:

THE CALL

- In 325 AD, Emperor Constantine called over 300 Christian bishops to Nicaea.
- The church faced confusion over Christ's identity was He fully divine or just a created being?
- The goal was to confirm Christ's true nature and combat heresy.

THE CONFLICT

- A priest named Arius taught that Jesus was not fully God but a created being.
- Church leaders, led by Athanasius, stood firm Jesus is co-equal, co-eternal, and co-existent with God.
- The council produced the Nicene Creed, declaring Christ as "begotten, not made" and "of one substance with the Father."

THE CONFIRMATION

- They defended doctrine, stating Jesus is fully God and fully man.
- They denounced deception, rejecting Arius' false teaching.
- They delivered a declaration, shaping Christian belief for generations.

John 1:1 KJV – In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

4 PROCLAIMED – The Gospel Preached to the World Matthew 28:19 (KJV)

- Power at Pentecost The Holy Spirit moved, and 3,000 were saved (Acts 2)
- Preached to People Paul carried the Gospel across nations
- Persecution Pushed It The church grew despite opposition
